# CANDANCE CAMERON BURE

***The creative life of Candace Cameron Bure has unfolded across decades, carrying a steady thread of faith that has matured alongside her career.*** From her early years as D.J. Tanner on *Full House* to her current role as an author and faith-centered storyteller, her body of work reflects an ongoing devotion to spiritual growth expressed through everyday life.

Her devotional *Rise and Renew: A 30-Day Devotional to Heal a Hurting Heart* arrives as a deeply personal extension of that journey. The book is structured as a daily invitation into healing, guiding readers through scripture, reflection, and prayer while centering the emotional realities women carry through grief, disappointment, and personal rebuilding. Each entry holds space for honesty while gently directing attention toward restoration through faith.

Bure's relationship with Christianity has remained a defining force throughout her life, though her understanding of it has expanded over time. She has shared in interviews that her faith became more intentional in early adulthood, especially as she stepped into marriage, motherhood, and the evolving demands of public life. This progression shaped the tone of her writing, which speaks from lived experience rather than distant perspective.

In discussing *Rise and Renew*, she explained that the devotional was created for moments when the heart feels heavy,

describing it as a companion for women navigating pain while still desiring closeness with God.

She has spoken about the importance of renewing the mind daily, emphasizing that small, consistent time with God reshapes emotional and spiritual resilience. Her words reflect a belief that healing unfolds through presence and repetition, forming a rhythm that supports lasting change.

Her social presence extends this message into a shared, daily language. She has written, "I am called by God to do great things. I am strong," reinforcing identity as something rooted in divine truth. In another reflection connected to her devotional, she shared that God's strength remains available in every season, encouraging women to return to that truth as often as needed. These expressions mirror the tone of *Rise and Renew*, where affirmation and scripture work together to reorient perspective.

The devotional carries the imprint of her personal experiences, including seasons within her marriage that required deep faith, humility, and recommitment. She has spoken about times of emotional strain that led her to rely more fully on prayer and scripture, shaping her understanding of what it means to heal a hurting heart. That understanding lives within the pages of the book, offering readers guidance that feels both grounded and compassionate.

Her evolution as an author has been gradual and intentional.



Earlier works introduced themes of discipline, kindness, and identity, while this devotional centers more directly on restoration. The shift reflects a deeper engagement with the internal landscape of faith, where transformation is nurtured through daily return rather than singular moments.

The influence of Rise and Renew can be seen in the way it meets women within their real lives. It offers structure that feels accessible, allowing space for reflection without overwhelming the reader. This approach resonates with a generation seeking connection with God in ways that feel integrated into their routines, rather than set apart from them.

Bure's contribution to faith-centered writing continues to expand through this work. Her voice carries familiarity shaped by years in the public eye, while her message speaks to something deeply personal within each reader. Through her devotional, she creates a space where women are invited to sit with their emotions, reconnect with scripture, and experience renewal as a steady, ongoing process.

Her writing reinforces the idea that purpose is discovered through alignment with God's presence, cultivated in moments that often go unseen. The impact of Rise and Renew lives within those moments, where reflection becomes clarity, and faith becomes something practiced, embodied, and sustained over time.
